Household Hazardous Waste

Residents of Port Blandford can drop off their household hazardous waste at Town Hall on Friday May 31, 2013 from 8:30 a.m. to 12 noon.

What to bring: paint, oil/fuels, propane tanks, misc:

insecticides, herbicides, cleaners, medications, fluorescent bulbs, automotive batteries and household batteries.

Items Not Acceptable: fire extinguishers, electronic waste, containers greater than 20L or 5 Gal, smoke detectors, biomedical waste (sharps), commercial waste and radioactive materials explosives asbestos.

f your income from all sources for the year 2012 is less than the basic personal exemption you must apply before July 1st, 2013 to be exempt from 2012 poll tax. After that date you will be held liable unless a written request is made explaining the reason for the delay.

Burning Permit

s of May 1st a permit to burn must be obtained from Department of Forestry for outdoor fires.

Please be very careful when burning dry grass or shrubs as fires can get out of control very quickly.
